The Need

In the 21st century child soldiers have become the new face of war.

- There are 300,000 child soldiers in the world.
- Around 50,000 children have been kidnapped in Northern Uganda alone.
- They make up 80% of the army.¹
- 30-40% are girls who then become child mothers.

A child mother is a girl kidnapped by a rebel army soldier, who is raped, and then gives birth to a child in captivity.

Rejected by her society, she stands alone and abandoned raising the next generation.

- The only refuge for these child mothers is a Internally Displaced Persons camp (IDP) where 1,000 people die per week.

After months spent listening to the stories of child mothers we discovered that the cry of their hearts was to be in a safe place together where they could be accepted and heal from their experiences. They longed for hope and a chance to be the women they were created to be.
